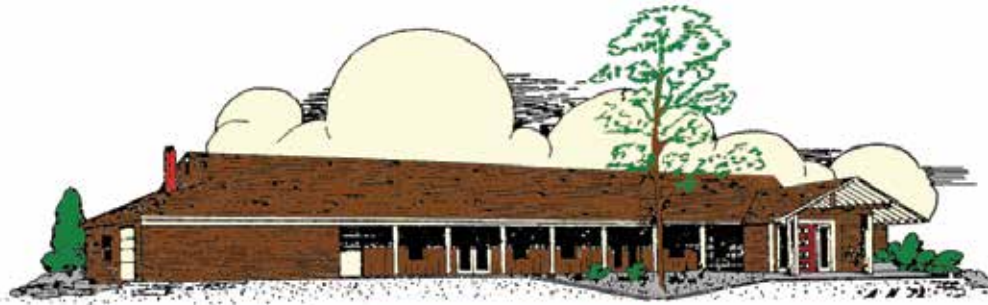

HELP WANTED - SRPE Treasurer (a paid position)

The Treasurer is an officer of the Board who is responsible for the Association's funds and securities and for keeping full and accurate accounts of all receipts and disbursements in the books belonging to the Association.

An aptitude for Excel, Word and Enumerate accounting software is essential to someone in this position as these tools are used extensively. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Preparation of a monthly income statement and report of account balances for each account held by the Association for publication in the monthly Association newsletter. Summarize Association Finances and announce at HOA meetings.
- Disbursement of funds for all regular and budgeted expenses as well as any other expense authorized by the Board of Trustees. Requires Purchase orders for any reimbursable expenses approved by a Trustee.
- Arranges for and provides information to the Certified Public Accountant for the yearly review and coordinates a Reserve Study every three to five years.
- Chairs the Finance Committee responsible for creating the yearly budget.
- Files yearly 1099s and reports quarterly payroll information to the accountant and manages users and associated permissions for all individuals requiring access to the Enumerate accounting and property management software.

DATE: June 6, 2024

TIME: 6:30pm – 25 Residents in attendance

- I. **Call to Order:** President, Phil Cupo, called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.
- II. **Speaker:** Cheryl L. Lewis, Vice President, Manasquan Bank presented on “Money Smart for Older Adults”.
- III. **Motion** – To appoint Pat Tatulli as Trustee Protem for Section 2. Pat took the oath of office.
- IV. **Roll call of Trustees:**
Present: Trudy Venkus, Pat Tatulli, Joan Ward, Pete Szyble, Susan Swain, James Clarke, Kathy Conte, Dave Fuhrman, Mary Conery, Mike Joffe, and Debbie Moriarty
Absent: Lorraine Witkowski
- V. **Presidents’ Announcements:** included Resignation of Dru Sangemino, Treasurer; Resignation of George Mascera and hire of Steve Nycz as Real Estate Liaison; Hire of Toni Gratzel as Recording Secretary; Hire of Nina Callari as Violations Chair; resignation of Section 3 Trustee Joan Ward as of October 1st; Annual Report and updated C&R’s available on website; Investment Club forming; Walkers are available for residents from the clubhouse; we have almost qualified for the second Trex bench which will be placed on Waldwick Court Circle; Encourage residents to sign up for No Knock through Berkeley Township; inclusion of new residents and deaths in the ECHO; Cost of DNA data base for dogs in the community makes it not feasible; 2025-2026 budget items planned for kitchen renovation, purchase of a utility cart and maintenance vehicle, updating the ladies’ room and Spring and Fall clean up by our landscapers.
- VI. **Approval of Meeting Minutes:** Minutes of the May 2, 2024, meeting was voted on and approved unanimously.
- VII. **Approval of the Treasurer’s Report:** Dru Sangemino reported we are on track for the first 2 months of the fiscal year.
- VIII. **Board of Trustees Reports**
 - A. **Administrative Report** was given by Mary Conery and included:
Real Estate Activity – 2 homes closed in March; 12 homes are for sale.
May Collections of fines was \$2,875.
Liens – 6 recorded liens; 5 new liens pending for unpaid dues and fines
Flippers - 5
 - B. **Berkeley Township Coalition Report** was given by Debbie Moriarty.
HR-7084 – “You Earned it, You Keep Act” is stalled in Congress.
S2930 – Looks to limit the amount of information given for an OPRA request.
NJDMV Van – will be at Holiday City South on June 26th for Real ID and other transactions. No more appointments are available. Check the DMV website for other sites. The coalition is hoping to have the van again at HCS.
Holiday City Carefree- has achieved 100% funding of their reserves through a special assessment.
Veterans Clinic – on Hooper Avenue scheduled to open July 1st.
- IX. **Unfinished Business:**
 - A. **ADA Bathroom update:** passed the rough and electrical inspections.
 - B. **Remote access** – to HOA and Agenda Meetings via Go to Meeting is planned.

X. New Business:

A. Curb Repairs – Joan Ward is working with the mayor’s office to have the damaged curbs in the community repaired. Several streets are planned for repaving and will have curb repair at that time. Joan is supplying the mayor’s office with a list of all the damaged curbs.

XI. Motions:

1. Mary Connery made a motion to hire Steve Nycz as Real Estate Liaison – *approved 9-2.*
2. Debbie Moriarty made a motion to hire Toni Gratzel as Recording Secretary – *approved 10- 1*
3. Dave Fuhrman made a motion to hire Nina Callari as Violations Chair - *approved unanimously.*
4. Kathy Conte made a motion to ratify the Architectural Committee’s approvals: Extension of concrete pad, fence around patio, replace asphalt driveway with concrete and a shed (7x7x7.6) at 22 Brian Court; Shed and deck extension at 16 Chancellor Court; Widen driveway with pavers at 8 Eve Place; 14x16 deck at 43 Southampton; Install a wood pavilion at 4 Chutney; 12x12 deck at 1016 Edgebrook Dr. East; and a 12x8x8 wooden shed at 1107 Waterberry Court. - *Approved unanimously*

XII. Section Reports:

Section 2 reported on issues with dogs, noise, garbage and grass cutting

Section 4 reported he picked up limbs throughout the community

Section 6 reported issues with grass cutting

Section 7 reported a resident thought someone was taking down a tree in the common area. Situation resolved.

Section 9 reported on issues with trailers on properties

Section 10 reported overall in community there are 17 grass cutting issues, 1 sent to the code enforcement

Section 12 reported that residents are taking an interest in the renovated circle on Sutherland Court and there have been complaints of men trespassing on properties while they cut through yards which frightens residents.

XIII. Clubs and Committee Reports of note:

Common Grounds – Receiving weekly complaints; dead tree on Sutherland circle to be replaced.

Entertainment Committee - Hawaiian Luau on June 22nd has sold out. The next event is the Annual Picnic on September 7th.

Flea Market/Junk in the Trunk - Next event is a Holiday Craft and Bake Sale on November 11th

Park ECHO – Deadline for July issue is June 6th

Sunshine Club - 3 Park Echo’s sent to former residents, 2 get well cards and 2 bereavement cards were sent. Please call Elva Hall with requests for cards.

Trees – reminder that trees are only taken down if they are dead, diseased or dangerous. They are not taken down because a resident doesn’t like them.

Violations Committee – grass cutting is the most frequent violation

Welcome Committee – 5 welcome packages were delivered

XIV. Give Aways – A \$25 Wawa gift card donated by the Flea Market was won by a lucky resident.

XV. Public comments - Discussion around using lot to park trailers (Not enough room in our lot), grass cutting on common grounds, Emergency vehicles response at clubhouse, private party barbeque.

XVI. Next Agenda meeting is June 20th at 10am. No HOA meeting in July, the next meeting is on August 1st at 7:00pm followed by an Ice Cream Social.

XVII. Adjournment: The meeting was adjourned at 7:50pm by President Phil Cupo

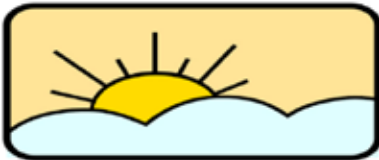
No Knock Registry

Once a resident signs up for this the Town will send a sticker for their front door. A company is provided a list of all addresses on the registry when applying for the permit. If someone does come to their house despite the sticker, they can call the police non-emergency number and report it. The violator is then subject to a fine and possible license revocation. This does not apply to religious, governmental, or political entities. Without the sticker, residents have no recourse other than not answering their door.

The Town cannot enforce the Association's solicitation prohibition.

Contractors of any kind (landscapers, roofers, etc.) are prohibited on Sundays.

Berkeley Township Ordinance 4-27.6 (b1):
Non-commercial or non-industrial power tools and landscaping and yard maintenance equipment shall not be operated between the hours of 8PM and 8AM.

BRUSH

Residents can place 4 feet tied bundles of brush at their curb on garbage day. Maximum weight of bundles is 35 pounds. Brush bundled properly will be picked up every week on garbage day.

LEAVES / PINE NEEDLES

Leaves and pine needles are collected April & May and November & December. They are to be placed in plastic bags. They should not be more than ¾ filled, must be left untied at the top and weigh no more than 50 pounds. Bags should be placed on the curb and left there. Check with Berkeley Township Sanitation for actual dates.

Recycling and Trash Cans

Please be courteous to your neighbors, put a lid on your cans, especially when wind and stormy weather are predicted.

Neighbors should not have to pick up your garbage.

The Ocean County Sheriff's Office participates in an international search and rescue program called Project Lifesaver. The project is designed for "at risk" individuals who are prone to wandering. It is a service to the public to decrease the strain on caregivers of people with Alzheimer's Disease, Autism, and other mental dysfunction disorders.

The Project Lifesaver officers are trained and certified to operate special tracking equipment to locate a client wearing a tracking wristband supplied by the Sheriff's office. The officer meets with the caregiver and client before a critical emergency of search and rescue.

To be eligible for the program the client must:

- ✓ Have a 24-hour caregiver
- ✓ Not drive
- ✓ Not live alone
- ✓ Have a history of wandering

Once eligible, an officer will visit and fit the client with a personal wristband.

SRPE Illegal Home Rentals

The Board has been informed repeatedly that some homeowners are renting their homes without notifying the Association – perhaps to avoid the \$300 fee, skirt age restrictions, or perhaps just plain ignorance.

This is a violation of our Covenants & Restrictions, which state that the Association must be notified before renting; the Tenant must be age 55 or older; and a home cannot be rented unless you have lived in it for one year as a primary residence.

It is also a violation of Berkeley Township ordinances requiring the owner/landlord to register with the Township, provide an age-approval letter from the Association, and pay a Certificate of Occupancy inspection fee, total amount of \$95 (2 separate checks made out to Berkeley Township: one for \$55 and the other for \$40).

Fees from house rentals help keep our dues from increasing and help keep your taxes down.

Most homeowners/landlords follow our C&R and Berkeley Township laws, but there are some who do not.

If you see someone moving into a house in our community, please call the office so we can verify that they have complied with these restrictions. The caller's name is always kept confidential.

Changes in Your Household?

In order to keep information on our community current, please notify the Office if there are any changes in your household.

This is necessary for statistical purposes.

Typical changes would include:

- A new or additional phone number
- A homeowner has deceased or moved from the residence
- A change in occupancy, such as someone moving into or out of the residence

To All Delinquent Homeowners

Although most homeowners pay their dues faithfully on time, there are several delinquent accounts in our park.

In an effort to bring severely delinquent accounts up to date, and upon the advice of the SRPE Attorney, please note the following:

If you are in arrears 1 year or more in your dues payments, you must call the Administrative Secretary to make arrangements to bring your account up to date.

Failure to do so may result in your being sued in court.

If there is a judgment made against you in court, you may be required to pay what you owe in dues, court costs, and attorney's fees.

A judgment may also affect your credit rating.

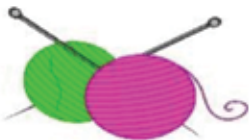

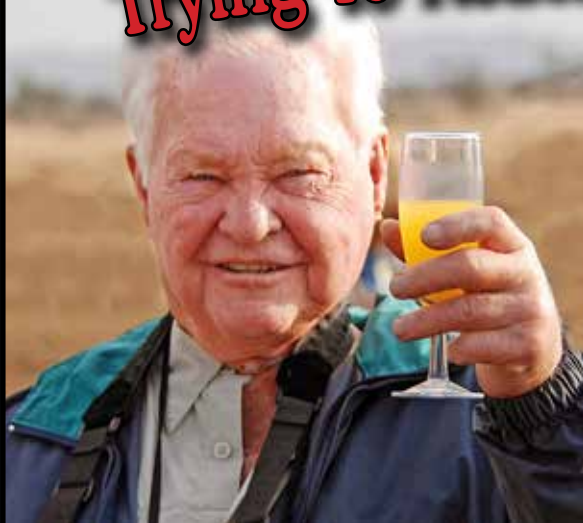

Planning to Sell or Rent? Read This First!

If you are a homeowner who is planning to put your home up for sale or rent, or if your home is currently for sale or rent without a realtor, you must contact the SRPE Clubhouse office immediately.

There are procedures, required by the Association and by Berkeley Township, that must be followed before a Closing of a Contract of Sale or Lease can take place.

- **Selling:** Article 11, Section 4 of our *Covenants & Restrictions* states, in part, that the owner of the property must notify the Association of the intended sale.
- **Renting/Leasing:** Article 10, Section(c) of our *Covenants & Restrictions* states that the owner of the property must notify the Association, in writing, that the prospective tenant meets the qualifications of membership in the Association.
- Berkeley Township requires a **“Continued Certificate of Occupancy”** (CO). Call the Berkeley Township Code Enforcement Office at (732) 244-7400, ext. 237, for more information.
