Silver Ridge Park Association, Inc. Homeowner's Association Meeting Date: August 1, 2024

Location: SRPE Clubhouse, 979 Edgebrook Drive N., Toms River, NJ 08757 Time: 7:00 pm – 27 residents in attendance (6 via GoToMeeting video conference).

- I. Call to Order: President Phil Cupo called the meeting to order at 7:05pm
- **II. Motion**: read by James Clarke to appoint Scott Stern as Association Treasurer, was seconded by Mary Conery and carried unanimously. Scott took the oath of office.
- III. Roll Call of Trustees:

Present: Trudy Venskus, Pat Tatulli, Pete Sztybel, Susan Swain, James Clarke, Kathy Conte, Mary Conery, Mike Joffe, Debbie Moriarty.

Absent: Dave Fuhrman, Lorraine Witkowski

- IV. President's Announcements: included acceptance for the Board appointed position of Vice President by Oliver Oramas; resignation of Toni Gratzel as Recording Secretary; the Association qualified for the second Trex bench to be located at the Waldwick circle.
- V. Approval of Meeting Minutes: Motion to approve Minutes of the June 26, 2024 Homeowner's meeting read by James Clarke, seconded by Mary Conery and approved unanimously.
- VI. Approval of the Treasurer's report: Treasurer Scott Stern reported that the Association continues to be on budget. Treasurer's report was approved unanimously.
- VII. Board of Trustees reports:
 - A. Administrative Report given by Mary Conery included:

Association Banking and Board approved signers: the Association By-Laws require two signers for each SRPE bank and on all SRPE checks, one Trustee and one Officer. The four banks at which the Association has accounts are Ocean First, Kearny Bank, Lakeland Bank and Manasquan Bank. The Board has approved Trustees Mary Conery and Kathy Conte, and Officers Scott Stern and Helen Griffin as signers on all Association bank accounts.

- **B.** Real Estate Report: There are 11 homes currently for sale; 2 homes sold in July; 8 current active liens and 12 vacant properties.
- C. Delinquent Accounts and Vacant Properties: The Board will be considering a motion at the August 15, 2024 agenda meeting to publish active liens in the Echo by address. These liens are published on the Ocean County Clerk's Office website and as such are a matter of public record. Given the number of vacant homes in the community, the Board requests assistance from owners to watch for any ill kept exteriors and/or individuals who may not belong in the community living in these homes and advise the office or their Trustee.
- **D. Beautification/Garden Club**: Regrettably, after multiple requests for participation by community members to assist in maintaining the grounds around the clubhouse, no homeowners have come forward to help. For this reason, we will be seeking estimates from area landscapers to fulfill the management of these garden areas.

VIII. Unfinished Business:

- **A. ADA Bathroom**: is almost completed and Berkeley Township inspections to date have passed. Flooring, additional heater, toilet, handrails and sink are installed. Doors are next. Total cost of the project is \$33,269.51. Paid for by the Ocean First Savings Account
- **B.** Curb Repairs: Berkeley Township has advised that the list of damaged curbs in the community will be addressed in 2025 as the budget will allow.
- **C.** A/C Repairs and replacement: Replacement of one of three air conditioning units (air handler and condenser). New mother board to second unit and one relay to third unit

replaced. All completed at a cost of \$17,436.88. Paid for by the Kearny Bank Reserve Money Market Fund.

IX. **New Business**

A. Reserve Study: Onsite inspection was conducted in July. We are waiting for the report and status of the reserve account. The purpose of the study is to evaluate the condition of the Association properties and the cost to maintain and/or replace them.

X. **Section Reports:**

- A. Sections 1 11 reported no issues
- B. Section 12 reported that the crepe myrtles are being watered by one of the section's residents and are thriving.

Committee Reports: XI.

A. Architectural Committee:

- Long Outstanding Requests: Kathy stated that there are currently 30 outstanding Architectural Committee requests awaiting approval, 4 of which are over 12 months old and have not been started or are still in progress: Fence at 1070 Edgebrook Dr.; Shed at 26 Brian Ct; Deck at 1143 Edgebrook; Reconstruction at 48 Southampton is an ongoing project and is exempt from the one-year rule but not from final inspection. Other Owners whose projects have not been completed and approved within one year will be required to complete a new request. She asked Owners whose projects have been completed to call the office and make an appointment for a final inspection.
- 2. House inspections prior to sale: are in progress. 8 inspections were conducted, 2 with issues – one resolved and one still open.
- 3. Current open requests and motion: for June: Shed at 26 Brian Ct; Deck at 31 Edinburgh; Fence at 110 Chamberlain. For July: Replace pavers at 45 Southampton; Flower garden at 1028 Edgebrook Dr.; Fence at 22 Edinburgh; Outdoor shower at 1039 Edgebrook; Deck at 3 Brian Ct. Motion to accept June and July Architectural requests read by Phil Cupo, seconded by James Clarke was approved unanimously.
- B. Common Grounds Committee: Mike reported that the landscape company doing lawn maintenance has changed ownership, but the workers remain the same.
- C. Entertainment Committee: Gail reported that she has 2 Grill Masters for the picnic. She is requesting more volunteers for the event. She announced there will be a Craft Fair and Bake Sale on November 16th.
- D. Echo: Gail stated that the deadline for any submissions for the September issue is Wednesday, August 7th.
- E. Violations: Nina reported that violations continue to be addressed.
- F. Sunshine Committee: Elva reported that she sent 3 sympathy cards, 3 Park Echoes to former residents and 4 get well cards. She accounted for her expenditures and requested reimbursement to replenish her account.
- **G.** Trees: Pat reported that he is responding to requests from homeowners and scheduling trimming and removal as appropriate.
- XII. Comments from the Membership: A number of owners asked why trees near their homes in the common area had orange tape around their trunks. Pat Tatulli stated he would inspect any trees not already on his list and have them taken care of as appropriate. Debbie commented that there have been no volunteers for the garden club, so it is now defunct.
- Next Meetings: Next agenda meeting will be held on Thursday, August 15th in the library; The XIII. next HOA meeting is scheduled for September 5th.
- XIV. **Adjournment:** The meeting was adjourned at 7:45 by Phil Cupo.


No Knock Registry

Berkeley Township does allow door to door soliciting by permit only. They do, however, offer a "no knock" registry. Form 04-34-OAB Registration Form – "DO NOT KNOCK" can be found on Berkeley Township website:

https://www.berkeleytownship.org/search.php?q=no+knock

Once a resident signs up for this the Town will send a sticker for their front door. A company is provided a list of all addresses on the registry when applying for the permit. If someone does come to their house despite the sticker, they can call the police non-emergency number and report it. The violator is then subject to a fine and possible license revocation. This does not apply to religious, governmental, or political entities. Without the sticker, residents have no recourse other than not answering their door.

The Town cannot enforce the Association's solicitation prohibition.

SRPE <u>Illegal</u> Home Rentals

The Board has been informed repeatedly that some homeowners are renting their homes without notifying the Association – perhaps to avoid the \$300 fee, skirt age restrictions, or perhaps just plain ignorance.

This is a violation of our Covenants & Restrictions, which state that the Association must be notified before renting; the Tenant must be age 55 or older; and a home cannot be rented unless you have lived in it for one year as a primary residence.

It is also a violation of Berkeley Township ordinances requiring the owner/landlord to register with the Township, provide an age-approval letter from the Association, and pay a Certificate of Occupancy inspection fee, total amount of \$95 (2 separate checks made out to Berkeley Township: one for \$55 and the other for \$40).

Fees from house rentals help keep our dues from increasing and help keep your taxes down.

Most homeowners/landlords follow our C&R and Berkeley Township laws, but there are some who do not.

If you see someone moving into a house in our community, please call the office so we can verify that they have complied with these restrictions. The caller's name is always kept confidential.

ATTENTION Delinquent Homeowners

To bring severely delinquent accounts up to date, and upon the advice of the SRPE Attorney, please note the following:

If you are in arrears 1 year or more in your dues payments, you must call the Administrative Secretary to make arrangements to bring your account up to date.

Failure to do so may result in you being sued in court. If there is a judgment made against you in court, you may be required to pay what you owe in dues, court costs, and attorney's fees. A judgment may also affect your credit rating.

Currently there are 41 residents in arrears and 8 Liens.

Garbage & Recycling Pick-Ups



PLEASE Help Keep Our Community Clean!!!

<u>Garbage/Trash</u>, items you wish to dispose of, and <u>Recycling</u> are <u>NOT</u> to be placed outside the front of your home, or on curb side, until after 4PM the day before their designated pickup days.

These are Berkeley Township ordinances which SRPE follows.

Handicapped Homeowners Can Get Assistance Getting Garbage Cans To Street

Have your doctor document the handicap, provide their name, address, and telephone and FAX to 732-349-7979. Sanitation workers will bring the garbage from in front of your garage to the truck and return containers to garage.

YARD WASTE

It has been noticed that there are some owners and renters dragging their foliage and yard waste to the **Common Grounds**. Please note that Berkeley Sanitation <u>DOES NOT</u> pickup in these areas, including yard waste left on the curb in the common area.

PLEASE BUNDLE OR BAG YOUR YARD WASTE AND PLACE ON YOUR CURB ON THE REGULAR GARBAGE DAY PICK-UP

Volunteers cannot keep cleaning up these common areas where folks dump their waste. There are too many common areas to keep up.

>> REMINDER <<

Article 10, Section (u) of SRPE Covenants & Restrictions states:

No work of a noisy or obnoxious nature should be done on Sunday before 10AM and after 6PM. Weekdays and Saturdays no noise before 8AM and after 8PM except in case of severe emergency conditions approved by the Board of Trustees. Contractors of any kind (landscapers, roofers, etc.) are prohibited on Sundays.

Berkeley Township Ordinance 4-27.6 (b1):

Non-commercial or non-industrial power tools and landscaping and yard maintenance equipment <u>shall not be operated</u> between the hours of 8PM and 8AM.

STREETLIGHT OUTAGES

Several ways to report outages:

Include Pole Number and address of the house nearest to the streetlight.

BRUSH

Residents can place 4 feet tied bundles of brush at their curb on garbage day. Maximum weight of bundles is 35 pounds. Brush bundled properly will be picked up every week on garbage day.

LEAVES / PINE NEEDLES

Leaves and pine needles are collected April & May and November & December. They are to be placed in plastic bags. They should not be more than ¾ filled, must be left untied at the top and weigh no more than 50 pounds. Bags should be placed on the curb and left there. Check with Berkeley Township Sanitation for actual dates.

Recycling and Trash Cans

Please be courteous to your neighbors, put a lid on your cans, especially when wind and stormy weather are predicted.

Neighbors should not have to pick up your garbage.

Project Lifesaver

The Ocean County Sheriff's Office participates in an international search and rescue program called Project Lifesaver. The project is designed for "at risk" individuals who are prone to wandering. It is a service to the public to decrease the strain on caregivers of people with Alzheimer's Disease, Autism, and other mental dysfunction disorders.

The Project Lifesaver officers are trained and certified to operate special tracking equipment to locate a client wearing a tracking wristband supplied by the Sheriff's office. The officer meets with the caregiver and client before a critical emergency of search and rescue.

To be eligible for the program the client must:

- ✓ Have a 24-hour caregiver
- ✓ Not drive
- ✓ Not live alone
- ✓ Have a history of wandering

Once eligible, an officer will visit and fit the client with a personal wristband.

Trip requests are not accepted via email. All trip requests are to be handled by telephone by calling (732) 736-8989, then press "1" to speak with a Reservationist.

The Reserve-A-Ride program is primarily designed to serve routine medical needs of Ocean County residents. Unlike the Fixed Bus Routes, this service does not operate on the basis of a printed schedule, rather routes and pick-up times are developed each day in response to the service requests we receive. All vehicles are wheelchair lift equipped.

Once your reservation has been made, the driver will arrive anytime within 1 hour to 1½ hours of the scheduled appointment time (depending on your travel distance). In accordance with Ocean Ride's Safety Policy, our **Drivers are not permitted to enter your home**, thus we require that you be at ground level for your scheduled pick up.



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

Planning to Sell or Rent? **Read This First!**

If you are a homeowner who is planning to put your home up for sale or rent, or if your home is currently for sale or rent without a realtor, you must contact the SRPE Clubhouse office immediately.

There are procedures, required by the Association and by Berkeley Township, that must be followed before a Closing of a Contract of Sale or Lease can take place.

- Selling: Article 11, Section 4 of our Covenants & Restrictions states, in part, that the owner of the property must notify the Association of the intended sale.
- Renting/Leasing: Article 10, Section(c) of our Covenants & Restrictions states that the owner of the property must notify the Association, in writing, that the prospective tenant meets the qualifications of membership in the Association.
- Berkeley Township requires a "Continued Certificate of Occupancy" (CO). Call the Berkeley Township Code Enforcement Office at (732) 244-7400, ext. 237, for more information.
